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Food Testing Tour at Old Dhaka

Tour Itinerary

- **Intro:**

This travel plan is designed for the food lover and who has got a passion for traditional and authentic local food of a country. It is, in fact, an elaborate full day sightseeing tour at old Dhaka along with the opportunity of photography and having food nearby key tourist places of Dhaka.

- **Pick - Up:**

Our driver and guide will come to pick you up from your hotel and start roughly at 7 o'clock in the morning

- **Visiting Kawran Bazar, the biggest local distribution points for agricultural product. :**

To see the morning life and back streets at old Dhaka along with breakfast and lunch our first stop will be at Kawran Bazar, the biggest wholesale market for everything in Dhaka and discovering the activity of buyers and sellers. This market is a true place of unlimited possibilities of photography particularly the fish market and it will give you an experience of the local distribution system of all food items that come from all over Bangladesh. We also will visit the nearby train station to see the local commuting train in Bangladesh if time permits.

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Having mouthwatering breakfast at Al Razzak, old Dhaka:

Roaming around this market and train station by this time you might feel very hungry and wait!!!! Something is waiting for you at Al Razzak, one of the rich restaurant menus in the old Dhaka where you will have a traditional breakfast item such as Luchi, Parata, nan Ruti, buna khichuri, vegetable, and special leg roast. Here the number of food items they will serve for you breakfast you cannot have all those, but we will try maximum number if item.

- **Visiting Sadarghat, Pink Palace:**

After testing all possible food at Al Razzak we move to Sadharghat and we will have a small boat trip to explore the Sadharghat and shipbuilding yard on the bank of Buriganga river we continue walking to the pink palace and visit the pink palace.

- **Visiting Hindu Street, Armenian church and star mosque:**

Then again start walking through Hindu street and we will have milk tea on the route you will discover a lot of people are having the morning tea here. The tea is very sweet but very tasty. We continue walking up to the Armenian church and spending some time there we move to star mosque after visiting star mosque we start walking again and on the route, we will try to have some Bakar Khani which one of the unique and signature food of old Dhaka.

- **Royal Hotel and it's delicious traditional Bangladeshi food:**

At this point in the tour we will be tired, and our stomach will need some fuel. From the star mosque, we will be reaching another famous old Dhaka restaurant called Royal hotel where you will find the authentic mouth-watering Bangladeshi food.

- **Visiting Lalbagh fort and Dhakeshawri Temple :**

After lunch, we will have a quick visit to Lalbagh fort and Dhakeshwari temple afterward.

- **End of the tour:**

We will drop you at your hotel with an everlasting memory of tour at old Dhaka.

We have a budget for lunch of 1000 BDT and 300 BDT for breakfast.

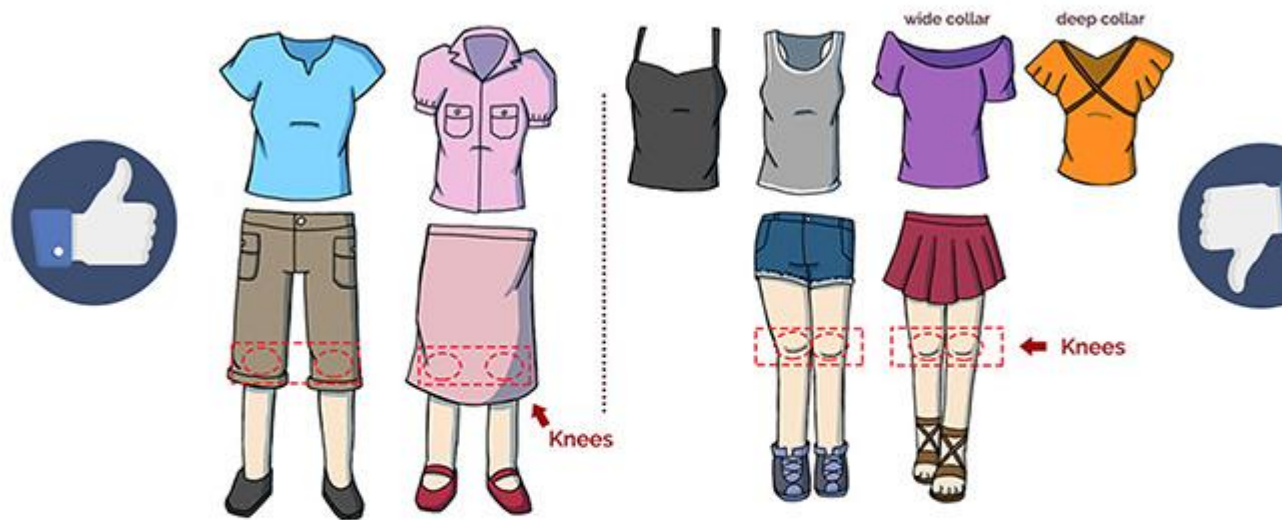
As this is a unique food tour any food guests want to test out of our menu will be beard by the guest.

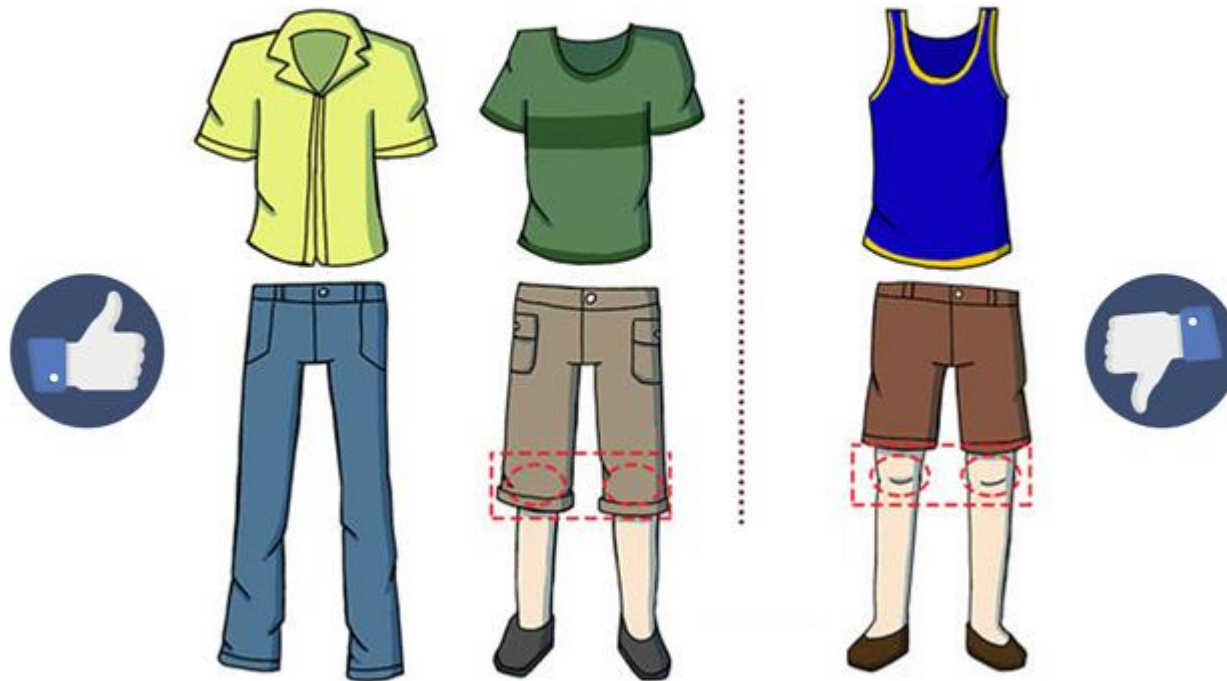
Dress code for women
